SENATE RESOLUTION

NUMBER SR-00F-1380

1 *SR-00F-1380 requests faculty to submit book orders by deadline.*

2 Whereas: The Student Government of the University of North Florida was established to represent
3 student concerns in all University wide matters, and;

4 Whereas: The Student Advocacy Committee is responsible for matters concerning pertinent
5 student issues, and;

6 Whereas: At the beginning of the Fall 2000 semester many students complained of books not being
7 available in the Bookstore when classes were starting, and;

8 Whereas: Due to this inconvenience many students were not prepared to begin their classes and
9 therefore fell behind immediately, and;

10 Whereas: During a Student Advocacy Committee meeting the committee members suggested and
11 approved a resolution to the faculty members of the University of North Florida, and;

12 Therefore: **Let it be resolved that all faculty members receive a memo encouraging them to submit their**
13 **book orders by the set deadline dates, and;**

14 **Therefore Let it be further resolved that this resolution be attached to the memo, and;**

15 **Further: Let it be further resolved to post the memo as soon as possible to insure that the next**
16 **deadline be met by the faculty members and to insure that books are available to the**
17 **students on time for the Spring 2001 semester.**
