19		Accommodations.....	\$158.00 x 5 nights = \$790.00 / 2 = \$395.00
20		Airfare.....	\$300.00 X4 = \$1200.00
21		Total Request Amount.....	\$1991.00.00

22 Therefore: Let it be enacted that \$1991.00 be allotted to AMSA for their trip to the 51st Annual
