7 Whereas: The Student Government of the University of North Florida was established to represent
8 student concerns in all University wide matters, and;

9 Whereas: The Budget and Allocations Committee is standing committee of the Student
10 Government Senate, which is responsible for "allocation of the Activity Service Fees,"
11 and;

12 Whereas: The Budgets and Allocations committee requests that the following monies be allotted to
13 Christine MacDonald to represent the Psychology Department at Eastern Psychological
14 Association Conference in Washington D.C. on April 20-22, 2001, and;

15 Whereas: This an honor for any undergraduate student to be accepted to present in the conference,
16 and;

17 Whereas: The Breakdown of monies is as follows:

18 **Registration \$20**

19 **Accommodations $\frac{1}{2}$ (2nights * \$100)= \$100**

20 **Airfare \$215=\$215**

21 Therefore: Let it be enacted that \$335 be allotted to Christine MacDonald to attend the
