### SB-01S-1392 Allows travel for the SCEC to the CEC Annual Conference

7 Whereas: The Student Government of the University of North Florida was established to represent  
8 student concerns in all University wide matters, and;

9 Whereas: The Budget and Allocations Committee is standing committee of the Student  
10 Government Senate, which is responsible for "allocation of the Activity Service Fees,"  
11 and;

12 Whereas: The Budgets and Allocations committee requests that the following monies be allotted to  
13 the UNF Student Council for Exceptional Children members to attend presentations at  
14 the CEC Annual Conference being held in Kansas City, MO; and

15 Whereas: UNF students will benefit from this trip when the leaders of SCEC bring the information  
16 to disseminate to others through the UNF Education Conference and seminars and;

17 Whereas: The Breakdown of monies is as follows:

18 **Registration.....\$109.00/person x 3 =\$327.00**

19 **Airfare.....\$281.00/person x3 =\$843.00 +Car rental= \$134.00= \$977.00 TOTAL**

20 **½ Accommodations.....\$430.00**

21 **TOTAL.....\$1734.00**

22 Therefore: Let it be enacted that \$1734.00 be allocated to the SCEC from the SG travel account to  
23 fund their trip to Kansas City , MO to participate in the CEC Annual Conference.
