### Number SB-01S-1398

### SB-01S-1398 Allows Conference Travel money to be allotted to the UNF Potters Guild

Whereas: The Student Government of the University of North Florida was established to represent

student concerns in all University wide matters, and;

Whereas: The Budget and Allocations Committee is standing committee of the Student

Government Senate, which is responsible for "allocation of the Activity Service Fees,"

and;

Whereas: The Budgets and Allocations committee request that the following monies be allotted to

the UNF Potters Guild for their travel to, and involvement in the National Council on

Education for the Ceramic Arts Conference (NCECA), and;

Whereas: The committee requests that registration and full accommodations be given, in place of

the transportation cost. This funding will be for four members, and;

Whereas: The breakdown of monies is as follows:

Registration Fee.....\$105.00 X4 people=\$420.00

Accommodations......\$129.00 X3 rm= \$387.00

Transportation......\$0.00

Total Request Amount.....\$807.00

Therefore:

Let it be enacted that \$807.00 be allotted to the UNF Potters Guild to take part in the

NCECA conference in Charlotte, NC.
