SENATE LEGISLATION

NUMBER SB-01S-1399

6 **SB-01S-1399 Allows two students to travel to the annual SEPA conference.**

7 Whereas: The Student Government of the University of North Florida was established to represent
8 student concerns in all University wide matters, and;

9 Whereas: The Budget and Allocations Committee is standing committee of the Student
10 Government Senate, which is responsible for "allocation of the Activity and Service
11 Fees," and;

12 Whereas: The Budgets and Allocations committee requests that the following monies be allotted to
13 fund the trips of two students to Atlanta, Ga. , and;

14 Whereas: LouAnne Hawkins and Irma Hall are registered UNF students that have conducted
15 empirical research and would like to present it at the annual meeting of the Southeastern
16 Psychological Association (SEPA), and;

17 Whereas: The Breakdown of monies is as follows:

18 **Registration.....\$10.00/person x 2 =\$20.00**

19 **Airfare.....\$140.00/person x2 =\$280.00**

20 **Roundtrip ground transportation between Atlanta airport & Hotel = \$35 x 2 = \$70.00**

22 **1/2 Accommodations.....2 rooms at \$440.00=\$880.00/2=\$440.00**

23 **TOTAL.....\$810.00**

24 Therefore: Let it be enacted that \$810.00 be allocated to the aforementioned students for travel to
25 Atlanta, GA to the annual meeting of the SEPA.
