14 15 16	Whereas:	LouAnne Hawkins and Irma Hall are registered UNF students that have conducted empirical research and would like to present it at the annual meeting of the Southeastern Psychological Association (SEPA), and;
17	Whereas:	The Breakdown of monies is as follows:

19		Airfare\$140.00/person x2 =\$280.00
20 21		Roundtrip ground transportation between Atlanta airport & Hotel = \$35 x 2 = \$70.00
22		<sup>1</sup> /2 Accommodations2 rooms at \$440.00=\$880.00/2=\$440.00
