- 9 Whereas: The Budget and Allocations Committee is standing committee of the Student
- 10 Government Senate, which is responsible for "allocation of the Activity and Service

- 17 Whereas: The Breakdown of monies is as follows:
- 18 **Airfare.....\$390.00 x 2 = \$780.00**
- 19 **½ Accommodations.....\$800.00/2 =400.00**
- 20 **TOTAL.....\$1180.00**
- 21 Therefore: Let it be enacted that \$1180.00 be allocated from the SG conference travel account is for
- 22 two UNF students travel to the Annual AMSA Conference in Anaheim, CA.
