# SENATE LEGISLATION

## NUMBER SB-01S-1404

*SB-01S-1404 establishes a Legislative Transition Period.*

- 2   Whereas:       The Student Government of the University of North Florida was established to represent  
3                    student concerns in all University-wide matters, and;
- 4   Whereas:       The Constitution and Statutes Committee is responsible for "reviewing the SG  
5                    Constitution and Statutes and recommend any change to the SG Senate when necessary,"  
6                    and;
- 7   Whereas:       Following the Elections of new Senate Officers, there is some confusion and unclerness  
8                    regarding the transition of the outgoing and incoming administration, and;
- 9   Whereas:       The Constitution and Statutes Committee is conducting a full statutory review of all  
10                   thirteen (13) statutes, and;

11   Therefore:     Let it be enacted that the following chapter be added to Title IV: The Legislative  
12                    Branch.

13                    **Chapter 407: Legislative Transition Period**

- 14                    407.1   The Transition Period begins upon the conclusion of Senate Elections by the  
15                    Student Senate and concludes after one week.
- 16                    407.2   During this transition period, the outgoing administration must transfer all  
17                    SG records and files, including a turnover folder (a folder containing all  
18                    procedures, forms, etc.), regarding the Senate to the incoming administration.
- 19                    407.3   The incoming and outgoing administrations shall share all office space  
20                    allocated to the legislative branch for purposes of conducting business relating  
21                    to the transition.
- 22                    407.4   All signature authority for the Student Senate shall be automatically  
23                    transferred upon the swearing-in of the new Senate President.
