SB-01S-1405 Allows IEEE travel to a conference in Clemson, SC.

7 -Whereas: The Student Government of the University of North Florida was established to represent
8 student concerns in all University wide matters, and;

9 Whereas: The Budget and Allocations Committee is standing committee of the Student
10 Government Senate, which is responsible for "allocation of the Activity and Service
11 Fees," and;

12 Whereas: The Budgets and Allocations committee requests that the following monies be allotted to
13 IEEE club for their involvement in and travel to the IEEE Conference and Paper
14 Competition, and;

15 Whereas: The Breakdown of monies is as follows:

- 16 **Registration.....\$50.00**
- Airfare.....\$232.00 x 2 = \$464.00**
- 18 **Rental Car\$32.00/day x 2 = \$64.00**
- 19 **½ Accommodations.....\$300.00 for 3 nights**
- 20 **TOTAL.....\$878.00**

21 Therefore: Let it be enacted that \$878.00 be allocated from the SG Conference Travel Account to
22 IEEE for their travel to the IEEE Conference and Paper Competition in Clemson, SC.
