SENATE LEGISLATION

NUMBER SB-01S-1412

1 *SB-01S-1412 establishes a Executive Transition Period.*

2 Whereas: The Student Government of the University of North Florida was established to represent
3 student concerns in all University-wide matters, and;

4 Whereas: The Constitution and Statutes Committee is responsible for "reviewing the SG
5 Constitution and Statutes and recommend any change to the SG Senate when necessary,"
6 and;

7 Whereas: Following the Elections of a new President and Vice President, there is some confusion
8 and unclearness regarding the transition of the outgoing and incoming administration,
9 and;

10 Whereas: The Constitution and Statutes Committee is conducting a full statutory review of all
11 thirteen (13) statutes, and;

12 Therefore: Let it be enacted that the following chapter be added to Title III: The Executive
13 Branch.

14 **Chapter 317: Executive Transition Period**

15 317.1 The Transition Period begins upon the validation of election results by the
16 Student Senate and concludes after the first Senate meeting of the term.

17 317.2 During this transition period, the outgoing administration must transfer all
18 SG records and files regarding Student Government to the incoming
19 administration.

20 317.3 The incoming and outgoing administrations shall share all office space
21 allocated to the executive branch for purposes of conducting business relating
22 to the transition.

23 317.4 All signature authority for Student Government shall be automatically
24 transferred upon the swearing-in of the new administration.

25 317.5 The swearing-in of the new administration must be held on the third weekend
26 (Friday, Saturday, and Sunday) in April. If a holiday occurs during this
27 weekend, the swearing-in may be held in the second or fourth weekend
28 (Friday, Saturday, and Sunday) of April.
