1		SB-01S-1413A makes changes to Title VII: The Impeachment Statutes
2 3	Whereas:	The Student Government of the University of North Florida was established to represent student concerns in all University-wide matters, and;
4 5 6	Whereas:	The Constitution and Statutes Committee is responsible for "reviewing the SG Constitution and Statutes and recommend any change to the SG Senate when necessary," and;
7 8	Whereas:	The Constitution and Statutes Committee is conducting a full statutory review of all thirteen (13) statutes, and;
9 10	Whereas:	During a review of Title VII: The Impeachment Statute, the Committee felt that the following addition was necessary, and;
11	Therefore:	Let it be enacted that the following be added to Title VII: The Impeachment Statutes.
12		704.5 In the event that a Senator is removed and then reinstated by either the Constitution and Statutes Committee or by the Office of the Judiciary, they
14 15 16		may be placed on a probationary period of time not to exceed one academic semester. Terms of probation (i.e. limited SG activity, etc.) are at the discretion of the Senate President.
17 18 19 20		704.6 Any Senator removed under the provisions of this chapter may be reinstated upon 2/3 vote of the Constitution and Statutes Committee. Any ruling of probation is made at the discretion of the Constitution and Statutes Committee.
