SENATE LEGISLATION

NUMBER SB-01S-1425

1 SB-01S-1425 Makes Changes to Title VIII regarding Disabled Students.

2 Whereas: The Student Government of the University of North Florida was established to represent
3 student concerns in all University-wide matters, and;

4 Whereas: The Budget and Allocations Committee is responsible for making any changes to Title
5 VIII, and;

6 Whereas: The members of the Student Senate believe that it is necessary to comply with all
7 provisions of the Americans With Disabilities Act of 1990 and Section 504 of the
8 Rehabilitation Act of 1973 (as amended), and;

9 Therefore: Let it be enacted that the following section be added to Title VIII: The Finance Code.

10 Chapter 817: Policies for Funding Students with Disabilities

11 817.1 Any student who wishes to request reasonable accommodations on the basis
12 of a disability in order to participate in any program or activity funded by
13 Student Government shall make such request in writing to the Director of the
14 Office of Disabled Services Program. The Director will provide confirmation
15 in writing to Student Government that the student is "disabled" and that the
16 accommodation requested meets the definition of a "reasonable
17 accommodation" under the Americans With Disabilities Act (ADA). The
18 student must provide to the DSP Office appropriate medical documentation
19 which meets the University's guidelines and comply with that Office's policies
20 and procedures. The DSP review process may take up to 30 days.
