CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT

NUMBER CA-01SA-1437

CA-01SA-1437 recommends the change of Article II, Section 6 and Section 8 to the SG Constitution.

Whereas: The Constitution and Statutes Committee is responsible for reviewing the

SG Constitution and Statutes and recommend any change to the SG

Senate when necessary, and;

Whereas: Joint Resolutions are formal opinions that state the will of Student

Government as a whole, and;

Whereas: The Senate currently has the power to override vetoed joint resolutions,

and;

Therefore: Let it be resolved that the following changes (see overhead) be

implemented to the Student Government Constitution, and;

Further: Let it be further enacted that the referendum be placed with the 2001

Fall Elections by the Elections, Selections, and Appointments Chair.
