## JOINT RESOLUTION

NUMBER JR-01SB-1439

1		Banning credit card vendors from soliciting on campus
2 3	Whereas:	The Student Government of the University of North Florida was established to represent student concerns in all University wide matters, and;
4 5	Whereas:	It is within the power of Student Government to issue resolutions of concern on the behalf of the student body of the University of North Florida, and;
6 7	Whereas:	Credit card vendors actively solicit students often using enticements and rewards for applying for credit cards;
8 9	Whereas:	Those students targeted by these companies are not properly educated about the ramifications of poor credit decision making;
10 11	Whereas:	The United States General Accounting Office has drafted a report to Congress addressing concerns with credit card companies that are arising across the nation;
- <b>)</b>	Whereas:	The university is making efforts to have an endorsed card, which will be the official card of UNF and offer benefits to students, including club funding and education efforts;
14 15 16	Therefore:	Let it be resolved that the Student Government of the University of North Florida no longer welcomes credit card vendors on this campus to actively solicit the student body;
17 18	Further:	This extends to credit card companies sponsored by campus organizations and auxiliaries and encompasses all forms of active solicitation;
19 20 21 22 23	Further:	Student Government endorses the university's efforts to have an official UNF credit card and exempts that company from this resolution as long as the company complies with Student Affairs policies when contacting students and offers benefits to students including education efforts. Student Government will work with Alumni Services to ensure that the official card is in the best interests of the student body;
24 25 26	Further:	Student Government pledges to start education efforts on campus to aid students in understanding the credit process, the importance of good credit and the ramifications of poor decision making.
