SB-01SB-1440 Makes changes to the SG Policies and Procedures

3 student concerns in all University-wide matters, and;

4 Whereas: The Constitution and Statutes Committee is responsible for "reviewing the SG
5 Constitution and Statutes and recommend any change to the SG Senate when necessary,"

8 Student Government Policies and Procedures that is to be conducted at the beginning of
9 the summer semester, and;

10 Whereas: The Constitution and Statutes Committee has completed the annual review of the
11 Student Government Policies and Procedures, and;

12 Therefore: Let it be enacted that the following recommendations be added to the Student
 Government Policies and Procedures (see overhead).
