1	3	SB-02F-1593: Anthropological Society Travel Request
2	Whereas:	The Student Government of the University of North Florida was established to represent student concerns in all University wide matters, and;
4 5 6 7 8	Whereas:	The Budget and Allocations Committee is a standing committee of the Student Government Senate, responsible for funding only those entities that comply with the Student Government mission which is to represent student concerns in all university wide matters while developing and promoting programs and activities of practical value and interest to students, and;
9 10 11	Whereas:	This purchase or activity reflects the genuine student interest and enhances the educational, social, cultural, and recreational interests of the University of North Florida students, and;
13	Whereas:	The Anthropological Society is a student organization on campus, in good standing with Club Alliance, meeting requirements to receive travel funding, and;
14 15 16 17	Therefore:	Let it be enacted, by the University of North Florida Student Government, that \$700.00 from the travel account 907027000 be used to pay for the Anthropological Society's conference trip.
