SB-03S-1652: Association of Information Technology Professionals Travel Request

2 Whereas: The Student Government of the University of North Florida was established to
3 represent student concerns in all University wide matters, and;

4 Whereas: The Budget and Allocations Committee is a standing committee of the Student
5 Government Senate, responsible for funding only those entities that comply with
6 the Student Government mission which is to represent student concerns in all
7 university wide matters while developing and promoting programs and activities
8 of practical value and interest to students, and;

9 Whereas: The AITP club is a CIS program based club at the University of North Florida,
10 and;

11 Whereas: They wish to attend a conference with other Information Technology
12 Professionals to compete and represent the students of the University of North
13 Florida, and;

14 Whereas: The cost of the trip would be:

15	Registration:	840.00=6 Students x \$140
16	Lodging:	255.00=2 Rooms x 3 Nights x \$85.00 x 1/2
17	Transportation:	1050.00=6 Plane Tickets x \$175.00 (Cannot Exceed)
18	Total:	\$2145.00;

19 **Therefore:** Let it be enacted, by the University of North Florida Student Government,
20 that \$2145.00 from the travel account 907027000 fund the AITP conference
21 trip to the AITP 8th Annual National Collegiate Conference in West
22 Lafayette, Indiana.
