SB-03S-1669 - Student Government Treasurer Position in Statutes

3 Whereas: The Student Government of the University of North Florida was established to represent
4 student concerns in all University wide matters, and;
- 5 Whereas: The Constitution and Statutes Committee is charged with maintaining and updating the
6 Student Government Statutes in order to ensure efficient and productive internal
7 operations, and;
- 8 Whereas: The Committee has passed through Student Government a Constitutional referendum to
9 create the mandatory position of SG Treasurer, and;
- 10 Whereas: There exists no language to fully define this position and the powers thereof, and;
- 11 Therefore: Let it be enacted, that pending student approval of the Treasurer position that the
12 following duties be assigned to such person:
- 13 301.1.C "Student Government Treasurer"
- 14 302.3.A "The Student Government President has sole power of appointment within the Executive
15 Office and may dismiss at his/her discretion, any appointment at any time with
16 the exception of Student Government Treasurer."
- 17 302.4.L "Chapter 315 - Office of the Treasurer"
- 18 Chapter 315 Office of the Treasurer

- 20 315.1 The Office of the Treasurer is an administrative support office responsible for ensuring
21 financial accountability and serving as the executive liaison to the student body on all
22 matters pertaining to Activity and Service Fee monies.

- 24 315.2 The duties of the Office of the Treasurer include:

- 26 A. Assist the Student Government Accountant and Student Government Budget Comptroller in
27 auditing all Activity and Service Fee accounts.

- 29 B. Report all Activity and Service Fee account errors, inappropriate expenditures, and other
30 activities that are in violation of state, local, or Student Government rules or regulations to the
31 Senate Budget and Allocation Committee and Student Senate.

- 33 C. Advise all entities that request Activity and Service Fee money on all state, local, and Student
34 Government rules and procedures.

- D. Serve as Ex-Officio non-voting member of the Senate Budget and Allocations Committee.
 - E. Enforce all policies and regulations set forth in the Title VIII of the University of North Florida Student Government Constitution and Statutes.
 - F. Enforce all restricted expenditures and provisional language of the Activity and Service Fee Budget.
 - G. Shall attend Club Alliance meetings and serve as the activity and service fee advisor to all chief financial officer to clubs and organizations.
- 315.3 The head of the Office of the Treasurer is appointed by the Student Government President, subject to confirmation by the Student Senate by a 2/3 vote, shall be referred to as the Student Government Treasurer, and shall serve on the Executive Cabinet.
