# SENATE LEGISLATION

## NUMBER SB-03F-1721

### SB-03F-1721: Jazz Ensemble Travel

2 Whereas: The Student Government of the University of North Florida was established to represent  
3 student concerns in all University wide matters, and;

4 Whereas: The Budget and Allocations Committee is a standing committee of the Student Government  
5 Senate, responsible for funding only those entities that comply with the Student Government  
6 mission which is to represent student concerns in all university wide matters while  
7 developing and promoting programs and activities of practical value and interest to students,  
8 and;

9 Whereas: This purchase or activity reflects the genuine student interest and enhances the educational,  
10 social, cultural, and recreational interests of the University of North Florida students and;

11 Whereas: The UNF Jazz Ensemble is a student organization of the University of North  
12 Florida in New York, NY from January 21, 2004 to January 24, 2004;

13 Whereas: The total amount of money requested is broken down into:

14	Registration Fees:	19 * \$90.00	<del>\$1,710.00</del>	
15	Transportation:	19 tickets * \$235.00	<del>\$4,465.00</del>	
16	<b>Total Amount Requested:</b>		<del>\$6,175.00;</del>	<b>3,175.00</b>

18 **Therefore:** Let it be enacted, by the University of North Florida Student Government,  
19 that ~~\$6,175.00~~ from the travel account 907027000 be used to pay for  
20 conference travel for the Jazz Ensemble. *3,175.00* *This amount shall be transferred into their foundation account.*

Outstanding Projects/Expenditures:

- 1) "Through His Eyes" Mixing (Includes 2 more Studio sessions) (\$5000+)
- 2) "Through His Eyes" Mastering (\$1500)
- 3) Annual Recording Design/Manufacturing (\$3000)
- 4) Jazz Ensemble member shirts (\$700)
- 5) CD Restock - "Things to Come" and "Second Thoughts" (\$2500 per CD)
- 6) "Collaboration" with Dale Wilson (to be recorded in May 2004) (Approx \$17,000)
