SB-04S-1740: Darrell Scott Lecture

2 Whereas: The Student Government of the University of North Florida was established to represent
3 student concerns in all University wide matters, and;

4 Whereas: The Budget and Allocations Committee is a standing committee of the Student Government
5 Senate, responsible for funding only those entities that comply with the Student Government
6 mission which is to represent student concerns in all university wide matters while
7 developing and promoting programs and activities of practical value and interest to students,
8 and;

9 Whereas: This purchase or activity reflects the genuine student interest and enhances the educational,
10 social, cultural, and recreational interests of the University of North Florida students and;

11 Whereas: The Darrell Scott Lecture would provide students with a motivational speech on
12 the topic of coping with personal tragedy, based on the events at Columbine High
13 School;

14 Whereas: The following expenditure would allow the Darrell Scott Lecture to serve the
15 students of the University of North Florida:

16 Advertising Fee: \$1,700

17 **Total: \$1,700.**

19 **Therefore: Let it be enacted, by the University of North Florida Student Government,**
20 **that \$1,700 from the Special Request Account 907098000 be transferred to**
21 **Special Projects Account 907041000 to be used to reimburse or pay for the**
22 **expenses related to advertising with the amount not exceeding \$1,700.**
