SENATE RESOLUTION

SR-04S-1746

1 *SR-04S-1746: Senate Resolution Concerning the Parking Situation*

2 Whereas: The Student Government of the University of North Florida was
3 established to represent student concerns in all University wide matters;

4 Whereas: In representing student concerns, the Student Senate believes that the
5 Parking Committee's recommendation was **not** in the interest of the
6 student body;

7 Whereas: The biggest complaint students have is parking availability and decal
8 prices on campus;

9 Whereas: Students recognize that every year the problem gets worse;

Whereas: But Students are forced to pay more for less, well above inflation rates;

11 **Therefore: May it be resolved, by the Student Senate of the University of North**
12 **Florida, that we plead the Board of Trustees to keep standard parking**
13 **decal at the current price (2003-2004), thereby reflecting student**
14 **sentiment and the reality of the campus parking situation.**

15 **Furthermore: May it also be resolved that we urge the Board of Trustees to reject**
16 **efforts to subject the second and third floor parking garages to anything**
17 **other than standard rates.**

18 **Furthermore: May it also be resolved that we urge the Board of Trustees to keep**
19 **equitable ratio's on all parking spaces, reserved and standard alike, to**
20 **make maximum use of our limited facilities.**

21 **Furthermore: May it also be resolved that we request that at least 50% of the**
22 **committee is composed of students for the coming years**

23 **Furthermore: Let this resolution be forwarded to University President John Delaney**
24 **and the Chair of the University Board of Trustees.**
