SB-04S-1751: AITP Club Travel

2 Whereas: The Student Government of the University of North Florida was established to represent
3 student concerns in all University wide matters, and;

4 Whereas: The Budget and Allocations Committee is a standing committee of the Student Government
5 Senate, responsible for funding only those entities that comply with the Student Government
6 mission which is to represent student concerns in all university wide matters while
7 developing and promoting programs and activities of practical value and interest to students,
8 and;

9 Whereas: This purchase or activity reflects the genuine student interest and enhances the educational,
10 social, cultural, and recreational interests of the University of North Florida students and;

11 Whereas: The AITP Club is a student organization of the University of North Florida
12 seeking to travel to Omaha, Nebraska from April 1, 2004 to April 4, 2004;

13 Whereas: The total amount of money requested is broken down into:

14 Transportation: \$740

15 **Total Amount Requested: \$740.00**

17 **Therefore: Let it be enacted, by the University of North Florida Student Government,**
18 **that \$740.00 from the Travel Account 907027000 be used to pay for**
19 **conference travel for the AITP club from April 1, 2004 to April 4, 2004 to**
20 **Omaha, Nebraska**
