**Hugh M. Brown of Titusville Re-Elected to Serve on Blue Cross and Blue Shield of Florida's Board of Directors**

JACKSONVILLE -- Hugh M. Brown of Titusville has been re-elected to a three-year term on the board of directors of Blue Cross and Blue Shield of Florida (BCBSF). He was first elected to a one-year term on the board in 1995.
