SB-04SA-1775 : Title VI - Campaign T-shirts Revision

2 Whereas: The Student Government of the University of North Florida was
3 established to represent student concerns in all University wide matters;

4 Whereas: The Student Senate is the legislative body of the University of North
5 Florida's Student Government given the responsibility of carrying out
6 such legislative acts that are necessary and proper for the Student Body of
7 the University of North Florida;

8 Whereas: Legislation dealing with necessary and proper statutory revisions shall be
9 considered by Student Senate;

10 Whereas: The Elections Statutes is in need of revision;

11 Whereas: The Student Senate's responsibility is to make our statutes proper for the
12 needs of our students;

13 Whereas: Election after election candidates and other individuals involved in
14 campaigning attend class illegally wearing campaign t-shirts;

15 Whereas: It is the intent to allow individuals to freely express their choice in the
16 Student Government elections, allowing for freedom of speech, while
17 protecting the educational process;

18 Whereas; The following revision shall be made to Title VI:

19 605.1 D. No active campaigning may take place within a classroom,
20 ~~excluding verbal campaigning~~ while class is in session.

21 **Therefore: Let it be enacted, by the University of North Florida Student Government,**
22 **that the proposed revisions are made into Title VI of the Student**
23 **Government Statutes.**
