SENATE LEGISLATION SB-04SA-1777

1		SB-04SA-1777 : Title VI – Appointment to the Senate		
2 3	Whereas:	The Student Government of the University of North Florida was established to represent student concerns in all University wide matters;		
4 5 6 7	Whereas:	The Student Senate is the legislative body of the University of North Florida's Student Government given the responsibility of carrying out such legislative acts that are necessary and proper for the Student Body of the University of North Florida;		
8 9	Whereas:	Legislation dealing with necessary and proper statutory revisions shall be considered by Student Senate;		
10	Whereas:	The Elections Statutes is in need of revision;		
11	Whereas:	The Student Senate's responsibility is to make our statutes proper for the needs of our students;		
13 14	Whereas:	The current reference made in 608.1 A. and 608.4 B. are no longer the correct references;		
15 16	Whereas:	It is left up for interpretation on whether an individual seeking appointment to Senate must attend the entire Senate Meeting;		
17	Whereas:	The references made in 608.1 A. and 608.4 B. shall be corrected;		
18 19	Whereas:	Title VI shall reflect custom, thus requiring individuals seeking appointment to attend an entire Senate meeting to be eligible for appointment;		
20	Whereas:	The following changes will be made to Title VI:		
21		Appointment to the Senate		
22		608.1 A. Fulfill every qualification specified in Chapter 605.1 of this statute.		
23 24		608.1 A. Be an A&S fee paying student, enrolled in at least one (1) class at the University of North Florida.		
25 26		608.1 B. Have at least a 2.00 cumulative grade point average, unless one has attended the University of North Florida for less than one (1) semester.

1		SB-04SA-1777: Title VI – Appointment to the Senate (Continued)		
2 3 4		608.1 В. <u>С.</u>	Attend at least one (1) <u>full</u> Senate meeting and go on record stating their first and last names <u>during the time allotted for recognition of students seeking appointment.</u>	
5 6 7		608.3 B. 2.	Appointees must run in the next scheduled election regardless of which seat they are appointed to, excluding the college and graduate seats.	
8 9 10 11 12		608.4 B.	The oath <u>as</u> stated in Chapter <u>608.3.B</u> <u>607.3 B. 1.</u> will be used to install those appointed, and will be administered by the Chief Justice or another member of the Judicial Branch as designated by the Chief Justice. If the Chief Justice or a designee is not available the Senate President shall administer the oath.	
13 15	Therefore:	Let it be enacted, by the University of North Florida Student Government, that the proposed revisions are made into Title VI of the Student Government Statutes.
