SB-04SA-1779: Title VI - Campaign Period

2 Whereas: The Student Government of the University of North Florida was established to
3 represent student concerns in all University wide matters;

4 Whereas: The Student Senate is the legislative body of the University of North Florida's
5 Student Government given the responsibility of carrying out such legislative acts
6 that are necessary and proper for the Student Body of the University of North
7 Florida;

8 Whereas: Legislation dealing with necessary and proper statutory revisions shall be
9 considered by Student Senate;

10 Whereas: The Elections Statutes is in need of revision;

11 Whereas: The Student Senate's responsibility is to make our statutes proper for the needs
of our students;

13 Whereas: There are currently numerous conflicts in dates surrounding the elections;

14 Whereas: The following changes will correct those conflicts and make the deadlines and
15 campaign period flow smoothly;

16 Whereas: The following changes will be made to Title VI:

17 601.1 J. Mark off the polling region with tape or other tangible items ~~48 hours~~
18 prior to Election Day two (2) business days before the first day of the
19 election. The Elections Supervisor or a designee must then remove all
20 posters and campaign literature from this designated area.

21 603.1 C. Students of UNF will be allowed ~~three weeks~~ a minimum of fifteen (15)
22 business days to collect published ~~campaign~~ candidate information from
23 Student Government before the deadline.

24 603.1 D. ~~Application deadlines for candidates wishing to appear on the ballot will~~
25 ~~be a minimum of two weeks before the set election date. Write-in~~
26 ~~candidates must submit appropriate forms at least 24 hours prior to the~~
27 ~~election.~~

1 **SB-04SA-1779: Title VI - Campaign Period (Continued)**

2 606.2 C. 1. The Elections Supervisor must mark off the polling region with tape or
3 other tangible items ~~48 hours prior to~~ two (2) business days before the
4 first day of the election. The Elections Supervisor or a designee must
5 then remove all posters and campaign literature from this designated
6 area. ~~From 48 hours prior to the election~~ Two (2) business days before
7 the first day of the election through election day(s), any campaign
8 material or vote-soliciting within this polling region will be considered a
9 violation of this statute and subject to the repercussions stated in this
10 statute.

11 606.3 B. 2. The Elections Supervisor must post in a newspaper of general campus
12 circulation the accessibility of absentee ballots at least fourteen (14) ~~ten-~~
13 ~~(10)~~ business days before the date of the election.

14 **Therefore: Let it be enacted, by the University of North Florida Student Government,**
15 **that the proposed revisions are made into Title VI of the Student**
16 **Government Statutes.**
