SENATE LEGISLATION SB-04SB-1790

SB-04SB-1790: Title VI – Spring Break Exclusion 1 2 Whereas: The Student Government of the University of North Florida was established to 3 represent student concerns in all University wide matters; 4 Whereas: The Student Senate is the legislative body of the University of North Florida's 5 Student Government given the responsibility of carrying out such legislative acts 6 that are necessary and proper for the Student Body of the University of North 7 Florida; 8 Whereas: Legislation dealing with necessary and proper statutory revisions shall be 9 considered by Student Senate; 10 Whereas: The Elections Statutes is in need of revision: Whereas: The Student Senate's responsibility is to make our statutes proper for the needs 12 of our students; 13 Whereas: In the previous Spring semesters a week of campaigning has been lost due to 14Spring Break being counted as a business day; 15 Whereas: The current and previous campaign period deadlines fell within Spring Break 16 because of its consideration as a business day; 17 Whereas: The following revision shall exclude Spring Break as business days and the 18 following changes shall be made to Title VI: 19 600.1 B. Business day - as referred to in this statute, shall be defined as being 20 weekdays (Monday through Friday) during academic sessions. 21 Academic Sessions include Spring, Summer, and Fall semesters 22 only. Spring Break shall not be considered as business days. 23 Therefore: Let it be enacted, by the University of North Florida Student Government, that the proposed revisions are made into Title VI of the Student 24 Government Statutes to take effect on the January 1, 2005 effective date. 25 STUDENT CENATE ACTION
