SB-04F-1824: Title VI - Campaign Material

- 2 Whereas: The Student Government of the University of North Florida was established to
3 represent student concerns in all University wide matters;
- 4 Whereas: The Student Senate is the legislative body of the University of North Florida's
5 Student Government given the responsibility of carrying out such legislative acts
6 that are necessary and proper for the Student Body of the University of North
7 Florida;
- 8 Whereas: Legislation dealing with necessary and proper statutory revisions shall be
9 considered by Student Senate;
- 10 Whereas: The Elections Statutes is in need of revision;
- 11 Whereas: The Student Senate's responsibility is to make our statutes proper for the needs
12 of our students;
- 13 Whereas: The current campaign expense process allows Presidential tickets and Senatorial
14 candidates to pool money together allowing them with an unfair monetary
15 advantage over individual candidates;
- 16 Whereas: The proposed changes shall alleviate some of the advantage a Presidential ticket
17 and/or Senatorial candidate has to pool money together;
- 18 Whereas: The following changes will be made to Title VI:
- 19 600.1 O. Party- Three (3) or more candidates cooperatively engaged in
20 campaigning.
- 21 600.1.P. Perishable Goods - Any food or drink
- 22 605.1 F. Any campaign material that is provided by a party shall be assessed
23 equally according to the number of people within the party to all
24 candidates' personal campaign expenses within the party.

605.2. E No perishable goods can be used for campaigning on either Election Day.

605.3. B.1.c. A Party shall be limited to:

a. Five hundred dollars (\$500) when a presidential ticket is not a cooperative member of the party.

b. One thousand dollars (\$1000) when a presidential ticket is a cooperative member of the party

Lines 600.1.O through 600.1V are shifted to become Lines 600.1.Q through 600.1.X

Therefore: Let it be enacted, by the University of North Florida Student Government, that the proposed revisions are made into Title VI of the Student Government Statutes to take effect on the January 1, 2005 effective date
