SENATE LEGISLATION

SB-04F-1826

1 *SB-04F-1826: Title XII - The Executive Agency Statute*

2 Whereas: The Student Government of the University of North Florida was
3 established to represent student concerns in all University wide matters;

4 Whereas: The Student Senate is the legislative body of the University of North
5 Florida's Student Government given the responsibility of carrying out
6 such legislative acts that are necessary and proper for the Student Body of
7 the University of North Florida;

8 Whereas: Legislation dealing with necessary and proper statutory revisions shall be
9 considered by Student Senate;

10 Whereas: Title XII is in need of revision;

11 Whereas: The Student Senate's responsibility is to make our statutes proper for the
12 needs of our students;

13 **Therefore: Let it be enacted, that Line 1203.6 be inserted and read as follows:**

14 By call of the Student Senate through legislation passed by majority vote
15 and signed by the Student Body President, Safe Ride can be placed on
16 inactive status.
