1		SB-04F-1827: Title V, VII, IX – Statute Revisions
2 3	Whereas:	The Student Government of the University of North Florida was established to represent student concerns in all University wide matters;
4 5 6	Whereas:	The Student Senate is the legislative body of the University of North Florida's Student Government given the responsibility of carrying out such legislative acts that are necessary and proper for the Student Body of the University of North Florida;
7 8	Whereas:	Legislation dealing with necessary and proper statutory revisions shall be considered by Student Senate;
9	Whereas:	Titles V, VII, and IX are in need of revision;
10 11	Whereas:	The Student Senate's responsibility is to make our statutes proper for the needs of our students;
12 13	Whereas:	Title IX is an unnecessary statute, which comprises materials that are pertinent to Title V and Title VII;
14 15	Therefore:	Let it be enacted, that Chapters 900, 901, 902, 903, 904, 905, 906, 907, and 908 of Title IX become Chapters 700, 701, 702, 703, 704, 705, 706, 707, and 708 of Title VII.
16	Further:	Let Chapter 909 of Title IX become Chapter 502 of Title V
17	Further:	Let Chapters 910 and 911 of Title IX become 709 and 710 of Title VII
18 19	Further:	Let Chapters 700, 701, 702, 703, and 704 of Title VII become Chapters 711, 712, 713, 714 and 715.
20	Further:	Let Chapters 502, 503, 504, and 505 of Title V become Chapters 504, 505, 506, and 507
21	Further:	Let Line 710.2 of Title VII read as follows:
22 23		If an officer is found guilty and is recommended for impeachment, separate charges must be filed.
24	Further:	Let line 707.4 of Title VII read as follows:
