SENATE LEGISLATION

SB-04F-1836

1 ***SB-04F-1836 : Title VI - Expiration of Appointment Applications***

2 Whereas: The Student Government of the University of North Florida was established to
3 represent student concerns in all University wide matters;

4 Whereas: The Student Senate is the legislative body of the University of North Florida's
5 Student Government given the responsibility of carrying out such legislative acts
6 that are necessary and proper for the Student Body of the University of North
7 Florida;

8 Whereas: Legislation dealing with necessary and proper statutory revisions shall be
9 considered by Student Senate;

10 Whereas: The Election Statutes are in need of revision and it is the Student Senate's
11 responsibility to make our statutes proper for the needs of our students;

12 Whereas: The current window for election dates allow only a two week deviation in the
13 election dates and do not take into consideration conflicts with University
14 scheduling such as holidays and Spring Break;

15 Whereas; The following addition would result in the voiding of an appointment application
16 if the appointee has not met the necessary requirements of becoming a senator
17 within ninety (90) days of submitting their application;

18 Whereas: The following changes will be made to Title VI:

19 **608.3 C. 3.** If an appointee has not attended and/or been reviewed by ESAC
20 within ninety (90) days of submitting their application, the
21 appointment application is then voided.

22 **Therefore: Let it be enacted, by the University of North Florida Student**
23 **Government that the proposed revisions are made into Title VI of the**
24 **Student Government Statutes.**
