SENATE LEGISLATION

SB-04F-1837

1 *SB-04F-1837 : Title VI - Grammatical & Numeric Revisions*

2 Whereas: The Student Government of the University of North Florida was established to
3 represent student concerns in all University wide matters;

4 Whereas: The Student Senate is the legislative body of the University of North Florida's
5 Student Government given the responsibility of carrying out such legislative acts
6 that are necessary and proper for the Student Body of the University of North
7 Florida;

8 Whereas: Legislation dealing with necessary and proper statutory revisions shall be
9 considered by Student Senate;

10 Whereas: The Elections Statutes is in need of revision;

11 Whereas: The Student Senate's responsibility is to make our statutes proper for the needs of
12 our students;

13 Whereas; The following changes would result in correcting and clarifying the intent of Title
14 VI subsections;

15 Whereas: The following changes will be made to Title VI:

16 **605.2 A.** No individual may ~~not~~ stand over voters while they complete their
17 ballot, except in the case of a disability, an individual with a
18 disability is permitted to request a poll worker or a representative
19 from the Disability Resource Center to assist ~~the voter~~ them while
20 voting.

21 **605.3 C.** No student may use Activities and Service fees (unless it is monies
22 collected from OPS wages) or ~~things~~ materials purchased with
23 Activities and Service fees to further their campaign.

24 **606.3 C. 5.** The Elections Supervisor and members of the Elections
25 Commission shall ensure that no one attempts to use ~~the library~~
26 their Osprey identification number or their social security number
27 ~~on voter affidavits~~ to determine the names of voters.

28 **606.2 B. 3.** All Senators not appearing on the ballot or running in the election
) are required to supervise a polling station for at least two (2) hours

2 during the time of elections. Any Senator not meeting this
3 requirement will be issued an absence.

4 **606.3 A. 5.** A sample ballot must be posted in the SG lobby within one (1)
5 business day following the deadline for applications and shall
6 remain posted for two (2) business days. Any errors must be
7 reported to the Elections Supervisor who will make corrections at
8 this time.

9 **606.3 C. 1.** Two (2) SG members not candidates in the election and/or the
10 Elections Supervisor must attend the polling station at all times to
11 ensure that this

12 **606.3 D. 3.** The Elections Supervisor shall order an immediate recount if the
13 difference between two (2) or more candidates is five (5) percent
14 or less of the total votes cast. If the results of the recount reveal
15 that a different candidate would be elected, then the Elections
16 Supervisor shall immediately order a third count. If the Elections
17 Supervisor does not order a recount, the Election Commission
18 must convene and order one.

19 **Therefore; Let it be enacted, by the University of North Florida Student**
20 **Government that the proposed revisions are made into Title VI of the**
21 **Student Government Statutes.**
