1		SB-04F-1843 : Title X Chapter Updates
2	Whereas:	The Student Government of the University of North Florida was established to represent student concerns in all University wide matters, and;
4 5 6 7	Whereas:	The Student Senate is the legislative body of the University of North Florida's Student Government given the responsibility of carrying out such legislative acts that are necessary and proper for the Student Body of the University of North Florida;
8 9	Whereas:	Legislation dealing with necessary and proper statutory revisions shall be considered by Student Senate;
10 11	Whereas:	The Constitution and Statutes Committee is responsible for making revisions to the Student Government Constitution and Statutes as needed, and;
12	Whereas:	Title X is in need of revision;
13 14	Whereas:	The Chapters within Title X: Code of Ethics have changed and the legislation within needs to be updated to be in accordance with the proper Chapters;
15	Therefore:	Let it be enacted, that the following changes be made to Title X:
16		Line 1001.2 read as follows:
17 18 19 20		No Student Government officer, employee, Branch, Agency, registered student organization, or any entity which receives any Student Government funding shall practice discrimination as defined in 1001.1 of the Student Government Statutes.
21		Line 1001.3 read as follows:
22 23 24 25		Upon finding a violation of 1001.2, the Office of the Judiciary shall be empowered to issue the following remedies: Suspension/loss of Student Government status, freezing/loss of Student Government funding, and/or probation.
