## SB-04F-1850

1		SB-04F-1850 : Title IX Chapter Updates
2 3	Whereas:	The Student Government of the University of North Florida was established to represent student concerns in all University wide matters, and;
4 5 6	Whereas:	The Student Senate is the legislative body of the University of North Florida's Student Government given the responsibility of carrying out such legislative acts that are necessary and proper for the Student Body of the University of North Florida;
7 8	Whereas:	Legislation dealing with necessary and proper statutory revisions shall be considered by Student Senate;
9 10	Whereas:	The Constitution and Statutes Committee is responsible for making revisions to the Student Government Constitution and Statutes as needed, and;
11	Whereas:	Title IX is in need of revision;
-12 -)	Whereas:	The Chapters within Title IX: Instillation and Eligibility Requirements have changed and the legislation within needs to be updated to be in accordance with the proper Chapters;
14	Therefore:	Let it be enacted, that the following changes be made to Title IX:
15		Line 900.1.B.1 read as follows:
16 17 18 19		If at any time their cumulative University of North Florida grade point average falls below 2.0, they shall be placed on probation as defined in <u>Title IX</u> , <u>Chapter 904</u> Probationary Period at the discretion of the designee as defined in <u>Title IX</u> , <u>900.1 B</u> subsections 2, 3, and 4.
20		Line 903.1 read as follows:
21 22 23 24		Except as provided by 903.2, all Student Government officers shall be required to take the oath of office specified in 903.3.
25 26		Line 904.1.A.2 read as follows:
27 28 29 30		The student, on probation, will be placed under limited Student Government activity at the discretion of the designee as defined in Statute X, Chapter 900.1B subsections 2, 3, and 4.
