7 8	Whereas:	The Student Government of the University of North Florida was established to represent student concerns in all University wide matters, and;				
9 10 11	Whereas:	e Student Senate is the legislative body of the University of North Florida's Student vernment given the responsibility of carrying out such legislative acts that are cessary and proper for the Student Body of the University of North Florida;				
12 13	Whereas:	Legislation dealing with necessary and proper statutory revisions shall be considered by the Student Senate;				
14 15	Whereas:	Title V, the Judiciary, requires changes, because the current statutes do not afford the Student Senate an adequate opportunity to interview appointments to the Judiciary, and;				
16	Whereas:	The following changes will be made Title V:				
77	Chapter 507 Appointment to the Judiciary					
19	, ,	To be appointed, one must chronologically be granted the following actions.				
21 22 23	•	507.1 Any individual interested in joining the Judiciary must fill out an application form and submit it to the Chief Justice.				
21 22 23 24 25 26 27		507.2 In the event of a vacancy on the Judiciary, the Student Government President must appoint a nominee, from the Judiciary applications to fill the vacancy.				
28 29 30		The nominee must then appear before the Constitution and Statutes Committee to present him or herself and receive a majority approval from the committee.				
31 32 33 34 35 36		Once approved by the Constitution and Statutes Committee, the nominee shall present him or herself at the very next Senate meeting, to receive majority approval of the Student Senate, by paper balloting, with the seat number of the voting senator in the corner. If appointed, the new justice shall be installed as outlined in Chapter 903 of these Statutes.				
37 38 39 40		507.5 Once installed as a member of the Student Government Judiciary, the term of the appointed shall last until their resignation from the Judiciary, or concurrently, the length of their tenure at the University of North Florida.

Let it be enacted, by the University of North Florida Student Government that the proposed revisions are made to Title V of the Student Government Statutes.
