9 10	Whereas:	This purchase or activity reflects the genuine student interest and enhances the educational, social, cultural, and recreational interests of the University of North Florida students and;	
<u>C</u>	Whereas:	In order to hear travel requests, the funds in Travel Index 402028 must be replenished.	
13 14 15 16	Therefore:	Let it be enacted, by the University of North Florida Student Government, that \$10,000.00 from the Special Request Index 402097 be transferred to Conference Travel Index Index 402028.
