CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT

## **CA-05S-1866**

Student Government

1	- 	CA-05S-1866: Travel Outside of Duval County
2 3	Whereas:	The Student Government of the University of North Florida was established to represent student concerns in all University wide matters, and;
4 5 6	Whereas:	The Student Senate is the legislative body of the University of North Florida's Student Government given the responsibility of carrying out such legislative acts that are necessary and proper for the Student Body of the University of North Florida;
7 8	Whereas:	The Constitution and Statutes Committee is responsible for making revisions to the Student Government Constitution and Statutes as needed, and;
9	Whereas:	The University of North Florida's Student Government Constitution is in need of revision;
10 11	Whereas:	Many Student Body Presidents have lived in the Jacksonville area, but outside of Duval County;
12	Whereas:	Florida Student Association travel outside of Duval County is part of the expected job duties of a Student Body President;
14	Whereas:	There is no comparable law in local, state, or federal books;
15 16	Whereas:	The Student Body President leaving the county is not an "extreme circumstance" worthy of a transition of power;
17 18	Therefore:	Let it be enacted that a Constitutional Referendum be placed on the 2005 Spring Elections by the Elections, Selections, and Appointments Chair, and;
19 20	Further:	Let it be further enacted that the referendum to be placed before the student body be submitted as follows:
21		Article III. Section 6. Subsection A. be instituted and read as follows:
22 23 24 25		The Vice President shall assume the duties of the President only in extreme circumstances, such as physical incapacitation or travel outside of Duval County, which makes it impossible to discharge the duties of the office.
