1	· · · · ·	CA-05S-1867: Election Bylaw Changes Requiring Simple Majorities
2	Whereas:	The Student Government of the University of North Florida was established to represent student concerns in all University wide matters, and;
4 5 6 7	Whereas:	The Student Senate is the legislative body of the University of North Florida's Student Government given the responsibility of carrying out such legislative acts that are necessary and proper for the Student Body of the University of North Florida;
8 9	Whereas:	The Constitution and Statutes Committee is responsible for making revisions to the Student Government Constitution and Statutes as needed, and;
10 11	Whereas:	The University of North Florida's Student Government Constitution is in need of revision;
1)	Whereas:	Voting procedures for Title VI are an aberration to the current norms;
13	Whereas:	It should take a simple majority to change election statutes;
14 15	Therefore:	Let it be enacted that a Constitutional Referendum be placed on the 2005 Spring Elections by the Elections, Selections, and Appointments Chair, and;
16 17	Further:	Let it be further enacted that the referendum to be placed before the student body be submitted as follows:
18		Article II. Section 10. Subsection A. be instituted and read as follows:
19 20 21 22		Enact under the procedures outlined in Section 7 of this Article, constitutional bylaws to be known as Student Government Statutes <del>,</del> with the exception of bylaws concerning elections, which shall require a two-thirds (2/3) vote of the Senate.
