JR-05S-1872: Students Rights

2 Whereas: The Student Government of the University of North Florida was established to
3 represent student concerns in all University wide matters, and;

4 Whereas: In representing students concerns, Student Government as a whole believes that
5 this concern should be addressed;

6 Whereas: The University of North Florida is an institution that should provide students with
7 an academic environment that promotes academic excellence;

8 Whereas: All students have the right to be provided with an academic environment that is
9 reasonable and just;

10 Whereas: It is unjust and against students rights for any professor(s) and instructor(s) to
11 hinder students from receiving an environment that promotes academic
12 excellence;

13 Whereas: These rights include the allowance of making up all work including but not
14 limited to exams, quizzes, tests and papers if the absence of class is reasonable;

15 Whereas: Reasonable being with proof of written hospitalization, sickness, doctors'
16 appointments, death and or emergencies;

17 Whereas: Any professor(s), instructors(s) that prohibit students from making up work
18 missed including but not limited to quizzes, test, exams, papers are not promoting
19 academic excellence and are in violation of students rights;

20 Whereas: These rights should be added to the Student Attendance Policy in the UNF Hand
21 Book;

22 **Therefore: Let this resolution be forwarded to the Vice President of Academic Affairs,**
23 **Dean of Student Affairs, Dean of College of Arts and Sciences, Dean of**
24 **Coggin College of Business, Dean of College of Computing, Dean**
