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# SENATE LEGISLATION

## SB-05S-1874

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### *SB-05S-1874: Club Alliance*

2 Whereas: The Student Government of the University of North Florida was established to  
3 represent student concerns in all University wide matters, and;

4 Whereas: The Student Senate is the legislative body of the University of North Florida's  
5 Student Government given the responsibility of carrying out such legislative acts  
6 that are necessary and proper for the Student Body of the University of North  
7 Florida;

8 Whereas: Legislation dealing with necessary and proper statutory revisions shall be  
9 considered by Student Senate;

10 Whereas: The Constitution and Statutes Committee is responsible for making revisions to  
11 the Student Government Constitution and Statutes as needed, and;

12 Whereas: Title XI is in need of revision;

13 Whereas: The current procedures for the Club Alliance Annual Funding Board is not up to  
14 date;

15 **Therefore: Let it be enacted, that the following changes be made to Title XI Chapter**  
16 **1205: Club Alliance:**

17 **Chapter 1105: Club Alliance**

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19 1105.1 Creation and Purpose

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21 A. Creation

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23 This Statute shall create an Agency of the Student Government Association  
24 known as ~~the~~ Club Alliance (CA).

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26 B. Purpose

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28 Club Alliance shall be responsible for providing support for student club  
29 functioning and club activities. Such support will include: financial and  
30 material resources, educational/developmental activities, coordination of  
31 mutual recruitment and entertainment activities, and the holding of regular  
meetings at which member clubs may conduct common business.

### *SB-05S-1874: Club Alliance*

#### 1105.2 Internal Organization and Structure

University recognized clubs become members by virtue of attendance at CA meetings. Membership is voluntary and clubs may join at any time. The CA will maintain a current Policies and Procedures that shall govern its internal structure.

##### B. Powers and Duties

The Director is a paid position working to provide support services to student clubs. Additional duties include maintaining an office, a Web site, and conducting bi-weekly meetings. As the head executive officer, the Director shall appoint and oversee the Chair positions of the ~~two~~ standing committees of the CA.

#### 1105.3 Assistant Director

##### B. Powers and Duties

The Assistant Director is a paid position working to provide support services to student clubs. Additional duties include aiding the Director in maintaining an office, a Web site, and conducting bi-weekly meetings.

#### 1105.4 Standing Committees

Club Alliance shall have the right to establish standing committees as the leadership determines necessary.

#### 1105.5

Individual clubs may only request funds in accordance with Title VIII.

#### 1105.6 Club Alliance Funding Board

A. The Annual Funding Board shall allocate club funding to members of Club Alliance.

B. The CA Annual Funding Board shall consist of the CA Director acting as chair, CA Assistant Director acting as vice-chair, ~~CA Faculty Advisor~~, Senate President, ~~Senate Pro-Tempore~~, Budget & Allocation Chair, Student Body Treasurer and an At-Large Member of the

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Student Senate appointed by the Senate President, and a member of a club at large chosen by the CA leadership.

C. Any ~~unallocated~~ request approved by the CA Annual Funding Board is subject to the final signature of the Student Body President. All actions should be acted upon within five (5) business days or assumed passed.

~~D.~~ If the president exercises a veto on the allocation it will be sent back to the CA Annual Funding Board Membership for 2/3 override vote at a regularly scheduled CA Meeting. and can be overridden with a 2/3 vote.

E. Each club must submit an annual Funding application with accompanying documents, if applicable, to the Annual Funding Board and then present this in an interview in front of the Board.

F. The Annual Funding Process must take place at the end of the Spring Semester in order to make funds available for the start of the following fiscal year.
