SB-05S-1876: Anime Club Travel

2 Whereas: The Student Government of the University of North Florida was established to
3 represent student concerns in all University wide matters, and;

4 Whereas: The Budget and Allocations Committee is a standing committee of the Student
5 Government Senate, responsible for funding only those entities that comply with
6 the Student Government mission which is to represent student concerns in all
7 university wide matters while developing and promoting programs and activities
8 of practical value and interest to students, and;

9 Whereas: This purchase or activity reflects the genuine student interest and enhances the
10 educational, social, cultural, and recreational interests of the University of North
11 Florida students, and;

12 Whereas: The Anime Club wishes to represent unf at a mega convention on Friday,
13 February 25th through Sunday, February 27th. The Anime being an active and
14 unique club in good standing wishes to send 22 of its members to compete and
15 learn more about Anime.

17 Total- \$880.00

18 **Therefore: Let it be enacted, by the University of North Florida Student Government,**
19 **that \$880.00 from Special Request Index 402028 be used to pay for the 22**
20 **members of the Anime Club to go to the Mega Convention in Orlando FL, on**
21 **February 25th-27th.**
