# SENATE LEGISLATION

## SB-04F-1890

1 *SB-04F-1890 : Peace Awareness Day*

2 Whereas: The Student Government of the University of North Florida was established to  
3 represent student concerns in all University wide matters, and;

4 Whereas: The Budget and Allocations Committee is standing committee of the Student  
5 Government Senate, responsible for funding only those entities that comply with  
6 the Student Government mission which is to represent student concerns in all  
7 university wide matters while developing and promoting programs and activities  
8 of practical value and interest to students, and;

9 Whereas: This purchase or activity reflects the genuine student interests and enhances the  
10 educational, social, cultural, and recreational interests of the University of North  
11 Florida students and;

12 Whereas: Peace Awareness Day is an event Amnesty International created to educate  
students and promote issues related to human rights, human equality, and peace;

14 Whereas: This event will benefit all students, faculty, and guests alike by providing diverse  
15 educational, social, and cultural interests through bands, speaker, international  
16 dancers, drum circles, poetry reading, and artwork; while recreational interests  
17 will be met through food, t-shirts, and performances;

18 Whereas: Students, faculty, and guests will be introduced to many different ethnic  
19 backgrounds and foods, as well as opinions on several issues, such as peace,  
20 human rights, war, helping the needy, world crisis, politics, and the environment;

21 Whereas: The requested expenses are as follows:
