SENATE LEGISLATION

SB-05SB-1927

1 **SB-05SB-1927 : Title V Changes**

2 Whereas: The Student Government of the University of North Florida was established to
3 represent student concerns in all University wide matters, and;

4 Whereas: The Student Senate is the legislative body of the University of North Florida's
5 Student Government given the responsibility of carrying out such legislative acts
6 that are necessary and proper for the Student Body of the University of North
7 Florida;

8 Whereas: Legislation dealing with necessary and proper statutory revisions shall be
9 considered by Student Senate;

10 Whereas: Title V is in need of revision;

11 Whereas: No transition statute exists for the judicial branch;

12 Whereas: A transition statute is needed when a new Chief Justice is elected by the council;

13 **Therefore: Be it enacted that the following text be added to Title V:**

14 **508 Judicial Transition Period**

15
16 508.1 The Transition Period begins upon the election of a new chief justice at the
17 annual chief justice vote by the Judiciary.

19 508.2 During this transition period, the outgoing chief justice must transfer all
20 records and files regarding Student Government to the newly elected chief
21 justice.

23 508.3 The incoming and outgoing judicial administrations shall share all office
24 space allocated to the judicial branch for purposes of conducting business
25 relating to the transition.

27 508.4 The Transition Period shall end at the request of the new chief justice, no
28 earlier than 1 month from the annual election.
