1		CA-05SB-1930: GPA Qualifications
2 3	Whereas:	The Student Government of the University of North Florida was established to represent student concerns in all University wide matters, and;
4 5 6	Whereas:	The Student Senate is the legislative body of the University of North Florida's Student Government given the responsibility of carrying out such legislative acts that are necessary and proper for the Student Body of the University of North Florida;
7 8	Whereas:	Legislation dealing with necessary and proper statutory revisions shall be considered by Student Senate;
9 10	Whereas:	The Constitution and Statutes Committee is responsible for making revisions to the Student Government Constitution and Statutes as needed, and;
11	Whereas:	The Constitution is in need of revision;
12	Whereas:	The University of North Florida Student Government qualifications for service do not meet the active standards of other university organizations and clubs;
14 15	Therefore:	Let it be enacted, that a Constitutional Referendum be placed on the 2005 Fall election by the Elections, Selections and Appointments Chair, and:
16 17	Further:	Let it further be enacted, that the Referendum to be placed before the student body be submitted as follows:
18 19 20 21 22 22		Article II, Section 2, Subsection C: Every Senator must be an A&S fee paying student, enrolled in at least one (1) class during both the fall and spring semester at the University of North Florida, and maintaining a 2.25 GPA or higher. Senators may continue to serve during the summer semester without being enrolled in a class as long as they are still considered students by the University of North Florida.
23 24 25 26 27	••••	Article III, Section 2, Subsection B: The President, Vice President, and all members of the Executive Branch must be A&S fee paying students, enrolled in at least one (1) class during both the fall and spring semester, and maintaining a 2.25 GPA or higher.
28 29 30		Article IV, Section 3, Subsection B: Qualifications: Justices must be A&S fee paying students, enrolled in at least one (1) class during both the fall and spring semester, and maintaining a 2.25 GPA or higher.
