# SENATE LEGISLATION

## CA-05SB-1932

### *CA-05SB-1932: Attorney General*

2 Whereas: The Student Government of the University of North Florida was established to represent  
3 student concerns in all University wide matters, and;

4 Whereas: The Student Senate is the legislative body of the University of North Florida's Student  
5 Government given the responsibility of carrying out such legislative acts that are  
6 necessary and proper for the Student Body of the University of North Florida;

7 Whereas: Legislation dealing with necessary and proper statutory revisions shall be considered by  
8 Student Senate;

9 Whereas: The Constitution and Statutes Committee is responsible for making revisions to the  
10 Student Government Constitution and Statutes as needed, and;

11 Whereas: The Constitution is in need of revision;

12 Whereas: The University of North Florida Student Government Attorney General should be a  
13 required position due to its necessity throughout the statutes;

14 **Therefore: Let it be enacted, that a Constitutional Referendum be placed on the 2006 Spring**  
15 **election ballot by the Elections, Selections and Appointments Chair, and:**

16 **Furthermore: Let it further be enacted, that the Referendum to be placed before the student body**  
17 **be submitted as follows:**

#### Section 8: Duties and Powers of the Attorney General

A. The Attorney General shall be an executive position appointed by the Student Body  
President and confirmed by a majority vote of the Student Senate.

B. The Attorney General shall be the Chief Prosecutor in all Student Government  
matters.

C. The Attorney General shall fulfill all job responsibilities as well as duties prescribed  
by law.
