SB-05SB-1933: Dismissal Of Duties

1

2 Whereas: The Student Government of the University of North Florida was established to
3 represent student concerns in all University wide matters, and;

4 Whereas: The Student Senate is the legislative body of the University of North Florida's
5 Student Government given the responsibility of carrying out such legislative acts
6 that are necessary and proper for the Student Body of the University of North
7 Florida;

8 Whereas: Legislation dealing with necessary and proper statutory revisions shall be
9 considered by the Student Senate;

10 Whereas: Title VI is in need of revision

11 Whereas: The current Title VI being outdated should allow for the Elections Supervisor to
12 relief Senators and there duty to work the polling station during the election.

13 **Therefore: Let it be enacted, that the following changes be made to Title**
14 **VI:**

15 **Chapter 602.2 Polls**

16 B. Hours

17 3. All Senators not appearing on the ballot or running in the election are
18 required to supervise a polling station for at least two hours during the time of the
19 election, unless otherwise excused by the Elections Supervisor. Any Senator not
20 meeting this requirement will be issued and absence.
