1		SB-05SB-1933: Dismissal Of Duties
2	Whereas:	The Student Government of the University of North Florida was established to represent student concerns in all University wide matters, and;
4 5 6 7	Whereas:	The Student Senate is the legislative body of the University of North Florida's Student Government given the responsibility of carrying out such legislative acts that are necessary and proper for the Student Body of the University of North Florida;
8 9	Whereas:	Legislation dealing with necessary and proper statutory revisions shall be considered by the Student Senate;
10	Whereas:	Title VI is in need of revision
1.2	Whereas:	The current Title VI being outdated should allow for the Elections Supervisor to relief Senators and there duty to work the polling station during the election.
13 14		Therefore: Let it be enacted, that the following changes be made to Title VI:
15		Chapter 602.2 Polls
16		B. Hours
17 18 19 20		3. All Senators not appearing on the ballot or running in the election are required to supervise a polling station for at least two hours during the time of the election, <u>unless otherwise excused by the Elections Supervisor</u> . Any Senator not meeting this requirement will be issued and absence.
