SENATE LEGISLATION SB-05SB-1938

	SB-05SA-1938: Campaign Period
Whereas:	The Student Government of the University of North Florida was established to represent student concerns in all University wide matters, and;
Whereas:	The Student Senate is the legislative body of the University of North Florida's Student Government given the responsibility of carrying out such legislative acts that are necessary and proper for the Student Body of the University of North Florida;
Whereas:	Legislation dealing with necessary and proper statutory revisions shall be considered by the Student Senate;
Whereas:	Title VI is in need of revision
Whereas:	The current Title VI being outdated should allow for all campaigning to begin on the same date.
	Therefore: Let it be enacted, that the following changes be made to Title VI:
	Chapter 605 Campaigning
	The Campaigning Period begins sixteen (16) <u>eleven (11)</u> business days before the first day of an election and ends the last day of an election.
