2	Whereas:	The Student Government of the University of North Florida was established to represent student concerns in all University wide matters; and

10	Whereas:	The following revisions are being made to Title VI;

12		603.1 Qualifying for Candidacy
13 14 15 16 17 18 19		D. Attend mandatory Candidate Seminars which shall be held on three (3) separate dates prescribed by the Elections Supervisor. All candidates must attend all three (3) scheduled seminars or meet with the Election Supervisor to qualify for candidacy. All information discussed in seminars shall be previously approved by the E&A committee. All additional questions answered will be shared via public notice and email.
20 21	Therefore:	Let it be enacted, by the University of North Florida Student Government that the proposed revisions to Title VI be made effective January 1st, 2011.
